September 22nd, 2021



Updated COVID-19 public health measures for gatherings, places of worship, events and a variety of businesses come into effect today and September 20. Establishments requiring proof of vaccination or a negative test will be eligible for the Restrictions Exemption

Program.

Effective today:

Indoor private gatherings are limited to 2 households (maximum of 10 people) for fully vaccinated, vaccine-eligible people and prohibited for vaccine-eligible individuals who are unvaccinated. Outdoor private social gatherings are limited to 200 people with physical distancing.

Places of worship must limit attendance to 1/3 fire code capacity, with mandatory masking and physical distancing.

Masks are mandatory for students in grades 4 and up, plus staff and teachers in all grades. Physical distancing and other measures apply to children's sport, performance and recreation activities.

Effective Sept 20:

Restaurants are limited to outdoor dining. 6 people per table.

Capacity limits on weddings and funerals. Indoor receptions are prohibited.

Attendance limits and mandatory masking and physical distancing in place for retail, entertainment and recreation facilities.

No indoor group sport, fitness, performance and recreation classes/activities permitted. One-on-one sessions are permitted with 3 metres of physical distancing in place. Starting Sept 20, businesses, facilities and events that qualify may implement the

Restrictions Exemption Program. These spaces can operate as they normally would.

Customers will need to provide government-issued proof of vaccination, a medical

exemption or proof of a negative, privately purchased COVID-19 test within the past 72 hours.

Those under 12 do not need to provide proof of vaccination or a negative test to enter a participating business.

If a business or service chooses not to require proof of vaccination, they must adhere to the new health measures instead.






