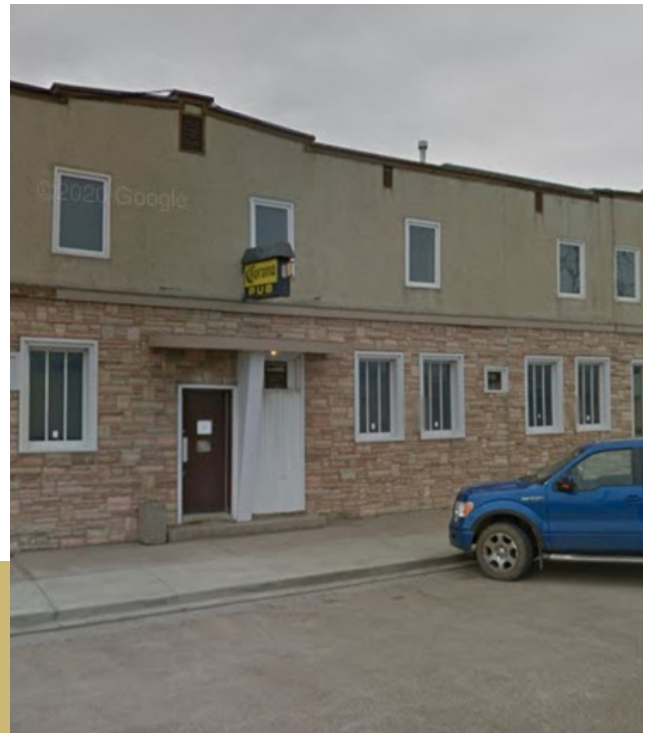

The hope is the ReJoyce workstation and the ReJoyce Touch will have a positive impact on the physical and mental wellbeing of the residents.
